TAXPAYER PROTECTION TOUR KICKS OFF IN SPRINGFIELD

St. Louis - Missouri Roundtable For Life kicks off its pro-life Taxpayer Protection Tour starting tomorrow in Springfield, Missouri. The day-long tour stop includes private meetings with citizens, leaders, and media members. The Taxpayer Protection Tour seeks to hear from all concerned parties about the state of public policy and the law in Missouri after the passage of Amendment 2, the so-called Cloning Amendment, in 2006. Participants will hear about Roundtable legal efforts and about a proposed Constitutional Amendment that would stop tax dollars from going to abortion and human cloning research.

"The taxpayers of Missouri need to know - right now - what is the law of the land in Missouri," said Roundtable President Ed Martin. "Today, Missourians tax dollars can be funneled to abortion providers and human cloners - this must stop!"

The Springfield stop on the tour will include an 11:30 am press conference at the Historic Greene County Courthouse located at 940 N. Boonville in Springfield. Roundtable board member and Treasurer Fred G. Sauer will speak to the press along with Roundtable President Ed Martin and noted pro-life State Senator John Loudon.

Also, a pro-life Townhall Meeting will be hosted at 7 pm by Keith Miller, Regional Coordinator for the Missouri Roundtable for Life, at the Executive Conference Center located at 910 W. Battlefield. Speakers will include Sauer, Martin, Loudon and Roundtable Executive Director Todd Jones.
